**Management Board Meeting** | **Wednesday 6 July 2016** | **Flockton Green WMC**

**Attendance:** Apologies were received from Andy Matthewman and Stuart Hawden. All other members were present.

**Minutes of Previous Meeting:** The minutes of the meeting on 2 February 2016 were agreed.

**Disciplines:** Most disciplinary matters have now been resolved.

There is a new dispute between Birchencliffe CC and Edgerton and Dalton CC in respect of the match played on 25 June 2016. The Management Board awaits the finer details of this issue before making investigations and taking appropriate action.

**20/20 Tournament:** As a result of the weather and clubs pulling out, the Management Board took the decision to slightly restructure the competition to enable the fairest possible result in the circumstances. The Management Board accepts and appreciates that the arrangements were not ideal but the Management Board did their best to accommodate the tournament in conditions which were out of their control. The Management Board issued statements to confirm the arrangements and these are available on the website.

**Results in Huddersfield Examiner:** The wrong results have been published in the Huddersfield Examiner this week. The Management Board will try to get hold of our contact there to see whether this can be looked at more closely in future.

**Loan Player Procedures:** The Management Board has received a complaint about how the loan players procedures are being used. No rules have been broken but a suggestion has been made that the Management Board should review the procedures at the end of this season (unless this is not applicable as a result of a merger).

**Finals:** The Alsop Cup final will be hosted by Green Moor on 24th July 2016. The Tinker Cup final will be held at Flockton on 7th August 2016. Alan Kaye's family are going to attend the Tinker Cup final to present the prizes for the cup in his honour and memory.
