

Huddersfield Central Cricket League



Full League Meeting | **Tuesday 18 October 2016** | **Flockton Green WMC**

Attendance: All clubs were in attendance save for Cartworth Moor CC who sent their apologies and Higham CC who did not. Apologies were received from Stuart Hawden and Neil Heppenstall.

Minutes of Previous Meeting: The minutes of the last meeting were approved.

Proposed Dissolution of the League: It remains the proposal that the HCCL will be dissolved at the AGM on 22 November 2016. The situation at present is as follows:

- Denby Grange CC, Horbury Bridge CC and Calder Grove CC have all been accepted to play in the Pontefract and District Cricket League in 2017.
- Higham CC and Green Moor CC had already been accepted to play in the South Yorkshire Cricket League.
- Birchencliffe CC, Leymoor CC, Mount CC and Bradley and Colnebridge CC have all made presentations to the Halifax Cricket League. Their clubs are due to vote on whether or not to accept these clubs in November.
- Almondburians CC, Cartworth Moor CC, Holmbridge CC, Edgerton and Dalton CC and Nortonthorpe CC have all applied to the Drakes Cricket League. Flockton CC and Augustinians CC have also approached the Drakes Cricket League. It is expected that a vote will not be held by the Drakes Cricket League until early to mid December.

As a result of the uncertainty of some of the above clubs being accepted into the respective leagues, any dissolution of the HCCL will be conditional on all clubs having secured a place in another league for the 2017 season. If any clubs fail to gain acceptance, the Management Board will call an emergency general meeting to decide how to proceed.

- Trophies:** A number of trophies are yet to be returned. Clubs will be fined if trophies are not returned expeditiously in accordance with the rules.
- Annual Dinner:** The annual dinner is booked for 3 March 2017. All clubs will be expected to buy a minimum of three tickets in accordance with the rules. Order forms will be circulated shortly. Ticket prices will remain the same as last year. There will be no increase despite the cost of the event itself increasing.
- Scorebook of the Year:** The Management Board decided that Mark Hepworth of Almondburians CC will be awarded the trophy for Scorebook of the Year. The Management Board wishes to thank all of the scorers that have worked with the HCCL and their clubs this season.
- Umpires Appointments:** The Management Board, along with Mick Tock (the Umpires Appointments Secretary), wishes to thank all of the umpires that have worked with the HCCL this season.
- Fines and Final Invoices:** All clubs should now have received their invoices. These must be paid before 31 October 2016. Clubs are reminded that any club which is in arrears at the time of the AGM will not be entitled to vote (in accordance with the HCCL rules).
- Section Winners:** The section winners were presented with their cheques. Mount CC were awarded with £250 as winners of the Premier Section. Birchencliffe CC were awarded with £200 as winners of Section A. Leymoor CC were awarded with £175 as winners of Section B.
