ANY OTHER BUSINESS

- The Umpires' Association had advised the League that the following mandatory rules had been received from the MCC and will need to be incorporated in the appropriate place in our own handbook. The notification of these changes came too late to be discussed at last year's AGM.
 - The captains shall toss for choice of innings in the presence of one or both umpires and the captain winning the toss shall immediately notify the opposing captain and umpires of his decision to bat or field.
 - The umpires shall be the sole judges of the fitness of the ground before any play commences. If no umpires are in attendance then both captains shall decide as to the fitness of the ground before any play commences.
- Requests for tickets for the League Dinner on Friday, 4 March 2011 should be with Jack Carson, League President by 13 February 2011.
- Evidence of Public Liability Insurance for £5,000,000 is required to be seen by Management Board member, Neil Heppenstall by 31 March 2011.
