**MINUTES**

The minutes of the meeting held on 9 August 2011 had been circulated and were accepted as a true record.

**MATTERS ARISING**

1. Replies still required from Birkby Rose Hill in response to letters sent 7 July and 11 August 2011 and they are reminded of Rule (Bye-Laws) 17Z - *"A club failing to satisfactorily attend to business &/or correspondence of the league shall be liable to be fined or otherwise penalised at the discretion of the Management Board"*.
2. Due to a typographical error onto the league registration list both offences involving Birchencliffe players N Smith and T Shaw, which were reported in the August minutes of the Management Board meeting, have now been dismissed and associated penalties removed. The Registration and Result secretaries send their apologies to Birchencliffe for this error.

**CORRESPONDENCE**

Responses received from Horbury Bridge and the umpire concerning the allegations of unsportsmanlike behaviour and lack of toilet facilities at Horbury Bridge during the Horbury Bridge B v Leymoor B game on Saturday, 30 July 2011. The Management Board has concluded that both sides were equally to blame for the "unsportsmanlike behaviour" during the match. The clubs were asked to remind their players of the "Spirit of Cricket" guidelines and no further action will be taken on this occasion. With regard to toilet facilities at Horbury Bridge CC, they have an arrangement with the Ship Public House to allow players use of their facilities and more notices will be placed around the club so that away teams are more aware of the current arrangements.

Letter received from Bradley & Colnebridge CC questioning why there was no slow over rate recorded against Silkstone B when they played Bradley & Colne B on 9 July 2011. An explanation from the umpires has been sent to Bradley & Colne.

### **ANY OTHER BUSINESS**

- In accordance with Rule 12C (last paragraph) a representative from Denby Grange CC was asked to attend to explain its conduct after failing to fulfil three fixtures. Assurances were given to the Management Board that recruitment for next season was in hand and that they fully expected to run two teams. The Management Board accepted the explanation and no further action to be taken.

- The Yorkshire Cricket Board honoured the volunteers in cricket at a ceremony held at the B & B Yorkshire Cricket Centre on Thursday 25 August 2011 celebrating outstanding achievements. Many congratulations to our winner from HCCL- Volunteer of the Year - Ian Heaton from Upper Hopton CC.

Ian Heaton has been involved with Upper Hopton for 10 years starting as a player and then assisting with the juniors when his son played. The small village club has usually had 1 or 2 junior teams but with Ian's involvement, it has led to teams at U9, U11, U13, U15 and U17. He became a qualified coach, Junior Cricket Manager and Club Welfare Officer. In 2009, the club decided to achieve Clubmark and he took the leading role in all that was required with it being achieved in May 2010.

However, it was acknowledged that the cricket net area needed renewal; and the 1962 pavilion was not up to present day standards. During 2010 plans for a £45000 building project for the pavilion, changing rooms etc was drawn up with a separate project of £7000 for a replacement cricket net and non-turf net pitches. Ian tackled the financing of the project and through various avenues of the external funding raised the full cost for the pavilion work, which will be commenced in October 2011. He also found the funding for the 3 required nets, which are now installed. It is his dedication and committed involvement, which brought the club into the 21st century offering great facilities and environment for the juniors.
