MINUTES

The minutes of the meeting held on 5 February 2013 were accepted as a true record.

MATTERS ARISING

Clubs reminded about their proof of Liability Insurance by N.Heppenstall.

CORRESPONDENCE

- Mount CC apologised for not attending the Centenary Dinner.
- Patience and understanding is requested by all clubs visiting Crossbank Meths and Crigglestone. Crossbank Meths are undergoing significant building improvements whilst Crigglestone are also rebuilding after the arson attack on their clubhouse. Temporary changing rooms etc are available.

- Clubs must use the Validate facility on Result Sheet and ensure that End-of-Innings statement is completed correctly on both innings.

- Birchencliffe announced that they have had issues with their square (due to the weather) but are doing all they can to ensure this will be ready for the start of the season.
- In the mail out from the YCB it states that the official language on the pitch is English. The mail out also states that the Disciplinary code now includes any incidents reported of abuse on social networking sites. Dependant on the severity of the abuse Police action may be taken.
- Each club has been given 10 handbooks and 5 Centenary Books which are available for sale at £10.00 each. Any unsold books are to be returned at the next meeting in June along with any monies for any books sold.
- Centenary ties are still available to purchase.
