EGM held Tuesday 12 June 2012 at Almondbury Wesleyans CC

The President welcomed everyone to the meeting and explained that the reasons for calling the meeting was to discuss the league structure for season 2013 considering there was a probability of up to 5 clubs leaving. He also wished to discuss the results of a recent survey and identify ways to improve the league and prevent further clubs from moving.

Clubs are intending to move for various reasons including

- **A new challenge**
- **Perceived higher level of cricket**
- **Problems with player recruitment**
- **Less travel**
- **Better facilities**

A full debate then occurred on the number of teams per section, the cup competitions, registration of junior players, start times, paid players and ground requirements etc.

It became very apparent that Sunday cup fixtures were a major problem for clubs and there were some concerns about ground facilities and junior registrations.

There was absolutely no support for the introduction of paid players into the league.

Many positive aspects of the league were highlighted regarding clubs that had improved their facilities over the years and the involvement with inter league competitions that had occurred.

A vote was taken and passed unanimously that in the event of more than 2 clubs leaving, the sections for 2013 will be determined by the final finishing positions of 2012, having taken into account promotion and relegation, with no club being allowed 2 teams in the same section other than the lowest section.

Clubs and Management Board are to reflect of the various issues discussed and submit any comments to the Hon Sec. Consideration to be given to appropriate rule changes where necessary.
