CORRESPONDENCE

Letter received from Denby apologizing for not being able to field a team against Flockton B on Saturday, 30 April 2011.

Complaint received from Woodfield Park B regarding incomplete team-sheet by Edgerton & Dalton B for Tinker Cup, Round 1 game on Sunday, 15 May 2011. Complaint upheld and letter of warning to be sent to Edgerton & Dalton. Result stands.

Letter received regarding incidents at the game between Nortonthorpe A and Cartworth Moor A on Saturday, 30 April 2011. Disciplinary panel will adjudicate in accordance with current ECB and YCA Discipline Guidelines.

Report received from the umpire regarding an incident at the game between Woodfield Park A and Higham A on Sunday, 24 April 2011. Disciplinary panel will adjudicate in accordance with current ECB and YCA Discipline Guidelines.

Further letter received from Thurstonland regarding unpaid teas by Edgerton & Dalton at game on Saturday, 7 August 2010. Despite several requests to Edgerton & Dalton no response has been received, therefore the League will pay the unpaid £6 to Thurstonland and bill Edgerton & Dalton on next invoice.

RESULTS SECRETARY'S REPORT

Only 1 instance of a team not phoning in a result (Old Almondburians B in Tinker Cup 1st Round), but clubs are reminded to commence their message with name of Section and restrict performances to 50 runs and 5 wickets – other performances will be automatically generated from the result sheet and linescore on website will be updated when result sheet is received early enough.

No instances of late result sheets but there have been a marked increase in the number of errors on result sheets and if this continues such sheets will be returned and become subject to fact that a fully completed sheet must be received by the 9 pm Monday deadline. Typical errors are:-

Name of Section
Name of Opponents
Name of batting team
Date of game

Always use drop down lists for teams and get the A and the B team correct

Don't forget the extras

Always check the accumulated number of overs and crosscheck that runs scored are in line with runs conceded plus extras.

Check that all bowlers who took a wicket have full bowling figures recorded against them

In case of a hyphenated name like G.Mason-Dixon leave out the hyphen, i.e. g.masondixon or better still g.mason where that name is unique.

Provided name is unique, you can truncate a name as above but do NOT use Dave when you have registered David (or ask Harry to change the registered name from Anthony to Tony etc)

The ties are shown as either/or for the cup draw for the Tinker Cup Competition due to the fact that a new rule was proposed by a club at the AGM and was passed by member clubs.

The rule on page 59 of the handbook which is as follows:- Tinker Cup Rule F replace with "From the first round of the Tinker cup, no player having played more matches in that season, for his club's first eleven than the club's second eleven shall be allowed to play in the Tinker cup. All players, excluding juniors (under 17), shall have played at least 3 matches in the club's second team to be eligible to play in the semi finals and final. A fine of £5 will be incurred for each breach of this rule".

A number of clubs have breached this rule and that is why the draw is shown as either/or until these breaches have been checked.

- Nominations for clubs to host the finals of the Allsop, Tinker, Armitage, and 20/20 cups to be received by the League Secretary by 1 July 2011.
- Clubs are reminded that all section trophies, Allsop, Tinker, Armitage, and 20/20 cups together with Man of the Match awards to be returned at the Full League Meeting on 14 June 2011. Failure to return any trophy will result in the club concerned being liable to a fine as per Rule 10D.

- Rule 70 and 7U Declarations
 Birchencliffe and Birkby Rose Hill will be fined £25 as per Rule 7C for late submission of declarations regarding 'No Professional' players and 'Overseas' players - I. Edgerton & Dalton have not returned their signed declarations and will also be fined £25 and will not be allowed to play any overseas player until the signed declaration is received by the league secretary.
- It is with sadness that we have to report the death of Richard Tyas of Denby Dale CC. On behalf of HCCL and the Management Board, sincere condolences are sent to Mrs Tyas and family.
- A loan of £1,000, repayable over 2 years, has been granted to Nortonthorpe CC to assist with renovations after severe weather damage to pavilion.
- Clubs are reminded that only capable scorers should be used, who are at least familiar with the basics of cricket scoring.
- The ECB directives and guidelines regarding overseas players states that "Tier 4 student entrants, i.e. who are in the UK to undertake long term studies such as university students, can play recreational cricket, but must not be paid, they cannot coach, and can only attend coaching courses if their visa specifically states this. Would clubs please note however that these students are classed as overseas players and the HCCL rule 7U clearly states that only 1 overseas player per club is permitted.
- Congratulations to Almondbury Wesleyans for their recent success in the Sykes Cup and Paddock Shield competitions and good luck for the next round. Commiserations to Cumberworth for their disappointment in the same competitions.
- Would players please take note of Rule 17F "The batting side shall be responsible for organizing a search for any BALL LOST during play". The Management Board ask that this be carried out swiftly to allow the game to carry on without too much delay.
