## **LEAGUE PRESIDENT'S ADDRESS**

## **LAW CHANGES**

The Chairman read out the law changes which he thought affected Umpires so he can vote on them at the League AGM.

- Rule 5 (F) – Page 41  
Replace with – League fixtures will be determined by The Management Board, taking into consideration the calendar and the number of matches to be played. No league fixtures, except those classed as re-arranged are to be played on a Sunday.  
  
The meeting voted against.
- Rule 5 (U) – Page 42  
Replace second sentence with – This will result in first offence will be a warning. Second offence with result in a deduction of one point, any subsequent offence with result in a deduction of 1 point plus a further point or points for every completed 5 minutes, i.e. 2 hours 47 minutes = 1 point plus 3 points deducted.  
  
The meeting voted for.

- Rule 5(V) – Page 42 Insert after completion of innings – at which time the crease markings are renewed as necessary. All clubs must ensure that their equipment store is available for such items, i.e. roller, marking frame, whitening for lines and sawdust.  
  
The meeting voted for.
- Rule 7(S) – Page 45 Replace with – A team sheet naming all the players will be completed and signed by both Captains – replace ‘play commencing’ with ‘the toss being made’. The sheet will remain etc. .... (This is to bring the League rule in line with MCC Law 1.2.)  
  
The meeting voted for.
- Rule 17(R) – Page 55 Insert – There must be 2 – insert ‘capable’ scorers at all times. etc.  
  
The meeting voted for.
- Allsop Cup Rule A(g) Replace with – Replace both instances of ‘£8 per extra visit’ with ‘£10 per extra visit’.  
  
The meeting voted for.

### **TRAINING OFFICER**

There is a Level One Course which started at the beginning of October. There will also be a revision course which will start the 1<sup>st</sup> February, 2012.

The Training Officer did a question and answer session using the new equipment and this was done during the Pea and Pie Supper and everyone seemed to enjoy the quiz.
