Huddersfield Central Cricket League
Proposed Rule Amendments 2010

Rule 1 (K) New	<u>Page 38</u> A junior is defined as a player that is under 17 years of age on the 31 August in the preceding year.
Rule 5 (I) Replace with	<u>Page 41</u> Each team shall receive 45 overs unless it is all out beforehand. If the team batting first do not complete their 45 overs, then the team batting second will receive the balance of the overs (full overs only) from the first innings. All bowlers to be restricted to a maximum of 12 overs.
Rule 5 (Z) Add	<u>Page 42</u> In the sentence, 'If they both agree the ground is unfit, the home club will notify the Umpires Appointments Secretary' – Insert by telephone as soon as possible, etc.....
Rule 7 New (to be inserted as new sub-rule 7B and then following rules moved down one letter)	<u>Page 43</u> Players in the under 12 yrs age group are no longer allowed to play Open Age Cricket except players who are selected in a County U12 squad in spring for a summer squad or in another squad deemed by the ECB performance managers to be a standard above 'District Level' for that season are eligible to play Open Age Cricket. This is providing they are at least 11 yrs old and in school year 7 on 1 st September in the year preceding the season and have written parental consent to play. In allowing these players to play in Open Age Cricket, it is essential that Clubs and Coaches recognise the 'Duty of Care' obligations towards these young players.
Rule 7 (C) Add	<u>Page 43</u> After the sentence 'Any club registering a player as an overseas player must clearly state any such player on their registration form' - Insert The declarations concerning any overseas player and the non-professional status must also be returned by 31 March prior to the start of the season. Any club in breach of this will also be fined £25. It is the responsibility etc
Rule 7 (J) Add	<u>Page 44</u> In the sentence 'Any player - Insert excluding juniors signing on before the start of a match etc
Rule 8 (C) Replace with	<u>Page 46</u> Failure to forward fully completed Result or Team sheets by the required time will incur the following fines: - first offence £5, second offence £10, third and fourth offences £20, thereafter £25 per offence. After the fifth offence, the club will be asked to appear before the Management Board. If a missing Result or Team sheet is not forwarded to the League within 7 days of receiving a reminder from a League official then the Management Board will add an extra £5 fine for every further week that the Result or Team sheet remains outstanding and a 1 point deduction will be made from that team's overall points total unless a satisfactory explanation is provided.
Rule 9 (B) Add	<u>Page 46</u> After the rule insert - The team batting second to score 2/3 of the runs scored by the side batting first to secure a point.
Rule 12 New (to be inserted as new sub-Rule 12B and then following rules move down one letter)	<u>Page 51</u> Any team unable to fulfil a fixture must notify the Umpires Appointment Secretary by telephone as soon as possible, but no later than 2 hrs before the scheduled start of play.
Rule 12 (B) Add	<u>Page 51</u> After the sentence 'The maximum points available on the day shall be awarded to the non-offending Club' - insert The offending team will also be deducted 6 points from their league total. After a

third broken fixture a team will be relegated (except section E)

<u>Rule 12 (E)</u> Add	<u>Page 51</u> After the rule insert - Any unfulfilled cup fixture will count towards the 3 broken fixtures for which a team could be relegated from their section
<u>Rule 14 (C)</u> Remove	<u>Page 53</u> The maximum price for such a tea shall be set by the League Management Board.
<u>Allsop Cup Rule H</u> Replace with	<u>Page 56</u> All playing members of a Club, including juniors, shall be eligible to play in the Competition with that club , providing that :- (i) If aged under 17, the player was registered no later than 7 days prior to the date of the fixture (ii) Otherwise, the player has played in the 1 st or 2 nd eleven for the Club before 31st May or was registered with the HCCL for that club by the first match of the season. No player registered on or after the day of a cup game will be permitted to take part in that game.
<u>Tinker Cup Rule F</u> Replace with	<u>Page 59</u> From the first round of the Tinker cup, no player having played more matches in that season, for his club's first eleven than the club's second eleven shall be allowed to play in the Tinker cup. All players, excluding juniors (under 17), shall have played at least 3 matches in the club's second team to be eligible to play in the semi-finals and final. A fine of £5 will be incurred for each breach of this rule.
<u>20/20 Rule L, M & N</u> Replace with	<u>Page 64</u> (Rule L) At the instant of delivery, for the first 6 overs of each innings only 2 fieldsmen are permitted to be outside the area known as "the fielding circle". For the remainder of each innings a minimum of 4 fieldsmen (plus the bowler & wicket-keeper) must be within the "fielding circle". In the event of an infringement, the Umpire shall call "NO BALL". The "fielding circle" is – an area bounded by two semi-circles centred on each middle stump (each with a radius of 30 yards) and joined by a parallel line on each side of the pitch. If the boundary edge is less than 30 yards from the middle stump, then the boundary edge will be classed as the edge of the "fielding circle". (Rule M) No more than 5 fielders can be on the leg side at any time.
<u>20/20 Rule P</u> Replace with	<u>Page 64</u> No balls (Overstepping) count as 1 run plus a free hit. No change to fielding positions if the same batsman is on strike
<u>Fixtures</u> New	Season to start one week earlier in April. Season to finish one week earlier (only two Sundays in September).
<u>Engagements</u> New	Should any failure to fulfil a fixture fall on the last 3 fixtures dates, then that match must be re-arranged. If the festival of EID should clash with the fixture programme then any matches affected to be played on an alternative date agreed by both clubs, (i.e. a Sat in Sept): if no agreement is made then the Management board will fix a date. If both clubs fail to play then neither club will receive any points
