- Attendance:** All management board members were present except Phil Senior, Ian Livesey, Brian Cooper, Stuart Hawden and Neil Heppenstall.
- Apologies received from Phil Senior, Ian Livesey, Brian Cooper, Stuart Hawden and Neil Heppenstall.
- Discipline:** There is an outstanding/ongoing discipline involving a player from Netherton CC in a match against Higham CC. The individual involved has been working away and so the discipline is still pending. The management board will ensure that a conclusion is reached by the AGM on 25 November 2014.
- Rearranged Fixture:** The Management Board have agreed to allow Holmbridge CC to have one rearranged fixture in the 2015 season following consideration of a letter received from the club.
- Augustinians:** Augustinians had approached the league previously about joining in the near future but they do not currently have any playing facilities. They have recently had their application for planning permission rejected. The application is due to be reheard and the management board will monitor this.
- Coloured Clothing Complaint:** Norththorpe CC have acknowledged receipt of the management board's response to their complaint about the wearing of coloured clothing during the 20/20 final. This matter is now closed. Please refer to the proposed rule changes in relation to the league rules regarding coloured clothing.
- Permission to Speak With Other Leagues:** Edgerton and Dalton CC have requested permission from the management board to approach other leagues.
- Most Sixes Nominations:** The management board have received one nomination for the player with the most sixes over the 2014 season. Confirmation as to the winner of this award will be announced by the management board shortly.
- Best Scorebook:** The management board decided that Crossbank CC will be awarded 'Best Scorebook' for 2014 after reviewing scorebooks from three different clubs.
- Most Improved Ground:** No nominations had been made for the 'Most Improved Ground' for 2014. It was suggested the Birchencliffe CC receive the award. The suggestion was supported by other members of the management board.
- Any Other Business:** The relevant management board members will prepare their annual reports and send them to the honorary secretary prior to the AGM.
