Management Board Meeting
Tuesday 25 November 2014
Flockton Green WMC

- Attendance:** Apologies received from Jack Carson and Andrew Matthewman. All other Management Board members were in attendance.
- Rearranged Fixtures for Galas:** At the previous Management Board Meeting, the Management Board agreed to allow Holmbridge CC to have one rearranged fixture in the 2015 season following consideration of a letter received from the club. They will therefore have no first or second team game on Saturday 11th July.
- The Management Board have received a request for a rearranged fixture from Denby Grange CC. They have requested that they have no 1st or 2nd team fixture on Saturday 16th May. This has been accepted by the Management Board.
- Structure For 2015:** If Flockton have a 'B' team next season, there will be 32 teams competing across the league divisions. If Flockton do not have a 'B' team, there will be 31 teams.
- The Management Board decided that the league would be structured as follows:
- Premier – 12 Teams
 - Section A – 12 Teams
 - Section B – 7 or 8 Teams
- The first league game of the season will be on Saturday 18th April and the last game will be played on Saturday 19th September. A full calendar for the season will be circulated in due course.
- Unfulfilled YCB Fixture:** Green Moor CC recently failed to fulfil a YCB fixture. It has been highlighted that YCB will have incurred unnecessary expense as a result of the broken fixture, as well as it being very disappointing.
- The Management Board will be writing to Green Moor CC to request an explanation of the circumstances which prevented them from fulfilling the fixture and why so little notice was given. Upon receipt of a response from the club, the Management Board will decide whether it is appropriate to take any further action.
- The Management Board would like to thank Heckmondwike and Carlinghow CC and Mount CC for their efforts in trying to fulfil the fixture at such short notice.
- Social Media:** Clubs were asked, in the full league meeting, to express any objections to the league, potentially, creating a Facebook and/or Twitter profile. No-one had any objections to the league trialling this, provided that it is monitored and policed appropriately. The Management Board will now look into this further.
- Next Meeting:** The management board will meet after the next full league meeting at Flockton Green WMC on 3 February 2015.
